

## Is my complaint Title IX?

Under Title IX,  
there are two types of  
cases:

### Sexual Misconduct

A broad term used to encompass a range of behaviors (sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence or stalking)

OR

### Discrimination

Being treated differently because of sex/gender

Report Here



### Report

Submit your report to the Title IX Coordinator through the Student Formal Complaint Form. Once received, it will be reviewed and determined which policy and laws apply and follow appropriate procedures



### Notice

After you file a formal complaint, the Respondent will be notified that a Title IX complaint has been filed and an investigation has begun. They will receive a summary of the complaint.



### Investigation

You and the Respondent will be interviewed separately, and both of you will receive written summaries of your statements. After reviewing all evidence, the investigator will issue a final report to determine whether the complaint is more likely than not to have occurred



### Decision

A designated CCC administrator reviews the investigation and makes a final determination of responsibility. If found responsible, disciplinary action may include suspension, expulsion, removal from roles, or termination.
